Minutes of Monthly Member Meeting September 18, 2023



Officers attending the meeting were: President Vinal Applebee, Vice-President Mike Cribbin, Treasurer Melissa Doane, Secretary Allison Applebee, and Trail Master Dave Soucier. Absent was Trail Master Randy Brown.

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 6:32 p.m.

Vinal Applebee welcomed all individuals attending tonight's meeting. Thank you for coming. He also welcomed newlyweds Jeff & Feleshia Harrell (married 9/16) who are also our newest members.

The **Treasurer's Report** was presented by Melissa Doane. Our starting balance on April 1, 2023 was \$75.95. Deposits so far for memberships, sponsorships, donations, map sales, fund-raising & grant reimbursement amounted to \$16,369.31. Expenses amounted to \$9,631.78. The Ending Balance as of September 8, 2023 is \$6,813.48. **Motion: To approve the Treasurer's Report dated September 8, 2023. Motion to approve by** Mutual Consent

The **Secretary's Report** was presented by Allison Applebee. We currently have 17 Associate Memberships, 67 Primary Memberships, 35 Family Memberships, 5 Business Memberships and 19 Premium Sponsors. We received one Family Membership at tonight's meeting.

The Trail Master's Report was presented by Dave Soucier:

- Lots of trail maintenance has been done in the past month. Thank you to all the volunteers who have joined us on the trails. The Trail Numbers are on all directional signs.
- The damaged bridge has been fixed by AFM. All signs for the bypass trail have been removed.
- We have hired Tony Madden to grade trails on AFM land. Tony is aware of our budget. Everyone be careful on the trails as you might encounter a grader.
- Bush hogging by tractor by Dave Soucier will be done as Dave's time permits. This will enhance our ride by widening some of the existing trails.

President's Report by Vinal Applebee:

- We have received our first grand money in the amount of \$5,573.26. This amount represents 90% of the total amount we sent in for processing. RMTR must cover the additional 10% in work or in-kind activity.
- Vinal wrote a letter to the Town of Milford Select Board asking for a \$1,000 sponsorship. The Selectman will hold a meeting tomorrow (9/19) and vote on this non-profit entity request. Vinal will attend the meeting.
- Facebook update: We currently have 1,299 followers. In the last 28 days, there were 2,725 reactions/comments/ shares with 18 new page Likes. 11,812 Facebook followers have been reached.
- We had a small turnout for our Blue Moon ride on August 31, but it was an enjoyable time. We stopped and socialized at the designated stop for about 30 minutes as the very bright moon rose over the "meadow".
- There is a new ATV club in the area the Cold Stream Cruizers. Former Trail Master Justin J-R from PORR is the club organizer. He hopes to create trails from Lincoln to Morgan's Beach in Enfield and the over to Howland. He has exciting plans for the Club.

President's Report (continued):

- A Bigfoot/Sasquatch Scavenger Hunt was held on Saturday (9/9) and Sunday (9/10). We would have liked a
 better turnout, but weather was once again a factor, nonetheless everyone who came out had a great time.
 Many took pictures with "Bigfoot" on the trail and emailed their pics to RMTR to win a prize. At the end of the
 ride, attendees enjoyed beans, hot dogs, coleslaw, chips, soda/water, and eatable Bigfoot Droppings.

We WILL have a Poker Run once or twice next year and will work on licensing this winter. Instead, we will have a BBQ and night ride tentatively scheduled for 10/7/23


